Key Vocabulary

Allah	The Arabic name for God.
Qur'an	The Muslim holy book.
Prophet	Someone who speaks on behalf of a God or someone who is an inspired teacher of Gods messages.
Mosque	A Muslim place of worship.
Ramadan	The ninth month of the Muslim year, during which strict fasting is observed from dawn to sunset.
Eid-ul-Fitr	The Muslim festival marking the end of the fast of Ramadan.
