Chronological	A list of events in time order.
King / Queen	A male/ female ruler of a place.
Parliament	The group of people who make decisions about the country.
Coronation	When a King or Queen is given the crown.
Law/ Rules	Actions that people must agree to follow.
Reign	The time that a monarch rules a country.
Timeline	Shows events in order of when they happened.
Decade	A period of 10 years.
