<b>The Royal Family</b>	The family of the King or Queen.
<b>Monarch</b>	A King, Queen, Emperor or Sultan.
<b>Chronological</b>	A list of events in time order.
<b>King / Queen</b>	A male/ female ruler of a place.
<b>Parliament</b>	The group of people who make decisions about the country.
<b>Coronation</b>	When a King or Queen is given the crown.
<b>Law/ Rules</b>	Actions that people must agree to follow.
<b>Reign</b>	The time that a monarch rules a country.
<b>Timeline</b>	Shows events in order of when they happened.
<b>Decade</b>	A period of 10 years.
