Key Vocabulary

Habitat	Where animals and plants live.
Living	An organism that moves, grows, responds, respire, reproduces and get rid of waste.
Never alive	These objects cannot move, breathe, grow, eat or do any of the other things that animals and plants can do.
Micro-habitat	A small area that is different to the surrounding habitat.
Food chain	A food chain shows how each living thing gets its food. Some animals eat plants and some animals eat other animals.

- To understand that living things need to live in suitable habitats.
- To explore the plants and animals that live in seaside habitats.
