## What is "Like"?

"Like" is a fun video maker and music idea editor. Young people are creating their own content to go on platforms such as YouTube, Twitch and TicTok. Within "Like" are very cool effects which can make videos more engaging to share on social media for those hoping to be the next Social Media Star. Children are continually trying to build more followers and the only way to do this is with engaging content. Vloggers (people who post video blogs online) are making millions of pounds. For some it is now a career and many young people aspire to be the same.

Unfortunately, "Like" also has issues: Young people need to follow guidelines and as a parent it is essential that you create boundaries and have conversations with your child about what is appropriate.

### TOP TIP!

#### Be involved.

Create videos together and discuss boundaries that you expect your child to keep to.



It is important to read reviews and decide whether your son or daughter is old enough to use "Like". As with any live streaming or video streaming it carries risk of exposure to inappropriate content and contact.

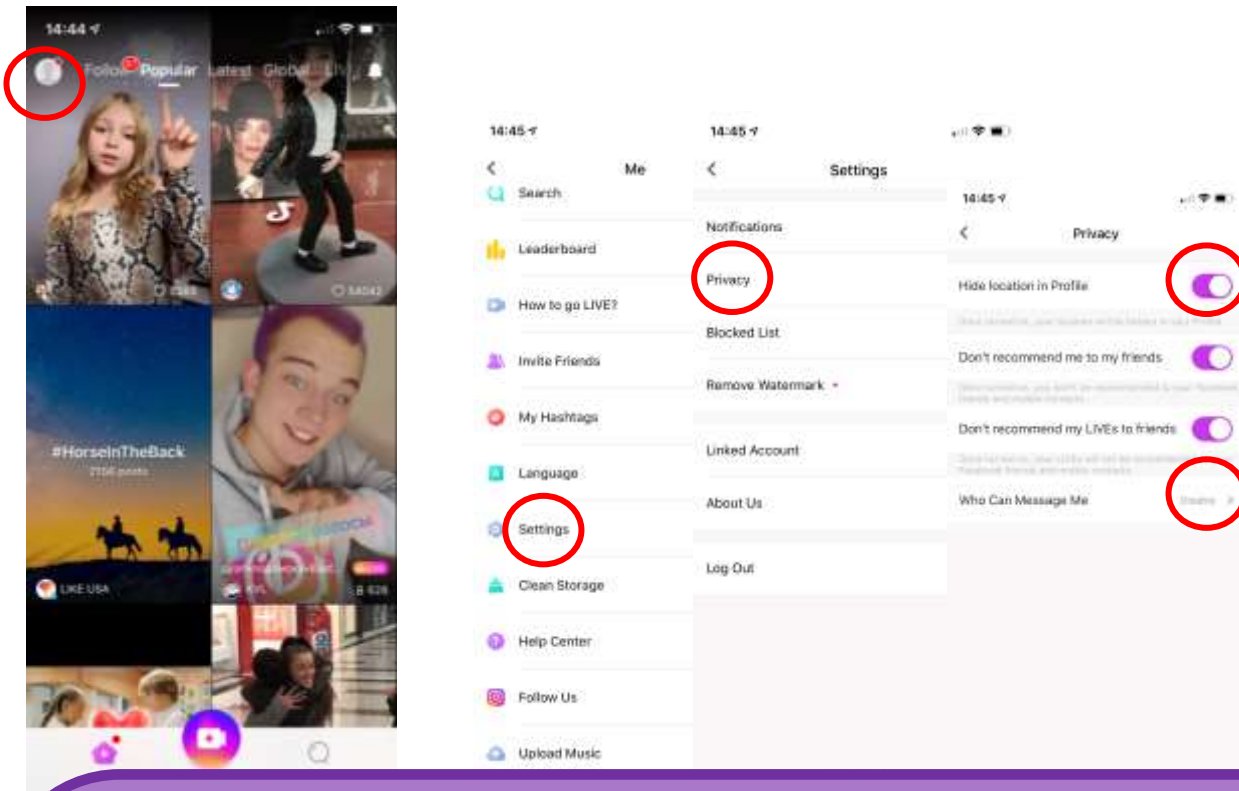

It is important to go in to “Like” and change the privacy settings, especially for younger children. See below:



### TOP TIP!

**Be involved – Sit with your child and look at content others have posted.**

Some good boundaries to agree with your child:

-  Do not identify your real name or location – use a nickname
-  Do not create any videos with your school uniform visible
-  Create the account together and select secure privacy settings
-  Never share rude or even scantily clad images.
-  Only communicate with real life friends
-  Tell immediately if they see inappropriate content or receive inappropriate contact.
