

Curriculum	Y6 Autumn Term 2 Learning
English	Trash Reading skills will be taught through this novel study. The Journey Writing and grammar skills will be taught through this novel study. At the end of the unit, the children will write a narrative recount. Greta Writing and grammar skills will be taught through this novel study. At the end of the unit, the children will write a speech.
Mathematics	Fractions - Fractions: Deepen understanding of equivalence; Order, simplify and compare fractions, including those greater than one; Recall equivalence between common fractions and decimals; Find decimal quotients using short division; Add and subtract fractions; multiply and divide fractions and find fractions of amounts.
Science	Light and Reflection In this unit the children will explore how light travels from light sources to our eyes; shadows; how simple optical instruments work (periscopes)
PE	Football: The children will be learning how to apply game skills with accuracy and control in football Dance: The children will practise and perform a dance sequence as part of a group
Computing	Graphing This unit explores the benefits of creating common graph types, digitally. Children will create a range of familiar graph types using the 2Graph and 2Calculate tools, exploring features that make it easy to present data in the best possible way. Blogging This unit allows children to explore blogs and their features, including how they can be used to engage an audience effectively. Children will plan and create their own blog post as well as commenting on other's blog posts.
RE	Christianity –How significant was it that Mary was Jesus’ mother? Start to explain the significance of why Mary was chosen as Jesus' mother. Start to consider my own response to the Christian belief in the Virgin Birth, showing respect to Christian views Make links between the Virgin Birth and Christian beliefs about Jesus (incarnation)

Music	Percussion Calypso Solèy Levé Know the features of a calypso, know what an arpeggio is, know the difference between tuned and untuned percussion and know the difference between the melody and accompaniment.
PSHE	Health and Wellbeing Set achievable goals, learn relaxation techniques, know how technology can impact their wellbeing and understand how vaccinations work.
French	Le passe et le present Be able to name places in a town, be able to describe what is/ is not in their own town, use and recognise numbers 70 – 100, be able to read and say numbers in years.
History	Census Understand what a census is and the information included in one, describe changes over time, use sources to verify data, plan a local history enquiry.
DT	Textile Bags Explore how textile bags are constructed, develop design ideas, create paper patterns and templates, cut out shapes and sew them together, evaluate the finished product.
