

Curriculum	Y1 Spring 1 Learning
English	<p>Writing</p> <p><i>Our writing for this half term will be based on Lost and Found by Oliver Jeffers. We will be learning how to hold a sentence and build a sentence. We will be learning about capital letters and full stops. We will write our own version of the story.</i></p> <p>Reading</p> <p><i>We will be reading our Read Write Inc books within our phonics sessions. We will also be enjoying listening to lots of stories and enjoying reading for pleasure. We will learn to recite a poem by heart.</i></p> <p>Grammar</p> <p><i>This half term we will be focussing on writing sentences with the correct use of punctuation.</i></p>
Mathematics	<p>Place Value - numbers to 20</p> <p><i>In this unit we will be understanding, comparing and ordering numbers to 20. We will be learning that numbers are made up of tens and some more.</i></p> <p>Addition and subtraction within 20</p> <p><i>In this unit we will be adding by counting on and using number bonds. We will be subtracting by counting back, using number bonds and finding the difference. We will also be looking at doubles and near doubles, related facts and missing number problems.</i></p>
Science	<p>Sensitive bodies</p> <p><i>In this unit we will be learning about human body parts and how we use our senses.</i></p>
Geography	<p>Villages, Towns and Cities</p> <p><i>In this unit we will be looking at the difference between villages, towns and cities. We will learn about the different land uses in a town and look at landmarks in different cities. In fieldwork, we will learn how to annotate maps with their key features.</i></p>
PE	<p>Gym</p> <p><i>In this unit we will be learning how to develop travelling actions, shapes, balances and shape jumps. We will also be learning how to perform barrel rolls, straight rolls and forward rolls.</i></p> <p>Invasion games</p> <p><i>In this unit we will learn about the roles of attackers and defenders. We will recognise who to pass to, move towards goal with a ball and support team mates when attacking. We will also learn how to move into a space and stay with a player when defending.</i></p>
Computing	<p>Data Explorers</p> <p><i>In this unit we will be learning how to use software tools to group and sort objects. We will also have the opportunity to collect and present data in a pictogram.</i></p> <p>Online Safety - perfect passwords</p> <p><i>This half term we will learn how to create perfect passwords and how to keep our passwords safe.</i></p>
Art	<p>Exploring watercolours</p> <p><i>We will be exploring different watercolour techniques. We will be looking at the work of Paul Klee and Emma Burleigh.</i></p>
RE	<p>Judaism</p> <p><i>The children will explore the question: Is Shabbat important to Jewish children?'. In this unit we will learn about the special things used during Shabbat and how Jewish children celebrate it.</i></p>
Music	<p>Magical musical aquarium</p> <p><i>In this unit we will respond to 'Aquarium' from The Carnival of the Animals. We will experiment with sound to create aquarium-inspired music, listen actively to Aquarium and refine our pieces and learn a sea-themed song.</i></p>
PSHE	<p>Safety and the changing body</p> <p><i>In this unit we will learn how to respond to adults in a variety of different situations. We will learn what to do if we get lost and how to make an emergency call. We will begin to recognise the difference between appropriate and inappropriate touch and begin to understand what is safe to put in and on our bodies. We will recognise safety in the home and understand that there are people in our community who help keep us safe.</i></p>
