English	<p style="text-align: center;">Writing</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Our writing for this half term will be based on Meet The Weather by Carly Hart. In this unit we will be learning how to use adjectives to describe nouns, use 'and' to join ideas in our sentences and use capital letters and full stops accurately.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Reading</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>We will be reading our Read Write Inc books within our phonics sessions. We will also be enjoying listening to lots of stories and enjoying reading for pleasure. We will learn to recite a poem by heart.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Grammar</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>This half term we will be focussing on using adjectives.</i></p>
Mathematics	<p style="text-align: center;">Place Value - numbers to 50</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will be understanding, comparing and ordering numbers to 50. We will be learning how to partition numbers into tens and ones, how to use a number line and find one more and one less than a given number.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Measurement – length and height</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will be comparing and measuring the length and heights of objects. We will then learn how to measure objects using centimetres.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Measurement – mass and volume</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will be using the language of heavier and lighter, full and empty. We will be measuring and comparing mass, volume and capacity.</i></p>
Science	<p style="text-align: center;">Comparing animals</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will be naming and describing the physical features of different animals, sorting animals into groups, identifying characteristics of different animal groups and investigating the diets of herbivores, carnivores and omnivores. We will also find out about the scientist Jane Goodall.</i></p>
History	<p style="text-align: center;">How have toys changed?</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will be discussing our favourite toys using language related to the past, asking questions about toys from the past, making comparisons between toys past and present, sequencing artefacts on a timeline, identifying changes between teddy bears and describing how toys have changed over time.</i></p>
PE	<p style="text-align: center;">Fitness</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will be learning how exercise can make you feel; how it can make you strong and healthy, how it relates to your breathing, how it can exercise your brain, how it can help your muscles and how daily exercise is important.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Sending and receiving</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will develop our throwing and catching skills over short distances and longer distances. We will then apply these skills to small games.</i></p>
Computing	<p style="text-align: center;">Data Explorers</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will be learning how to use software tools to group and sort objects. We will also have the opportunity to collect and present data in a pictogram.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Online Safety - perfect passwords</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>This half term we will learn how to create perfect passwords and how to keep our passwords safe.</i></p>
DT	<p style="text-align: center;">Stable structures</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>We will be investigating how to make a structures stable. We will then design, make and evaluate our own pencil pot.</i></p>
RE	<p style="text-align: center;">Christianity</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>The children will be learning about the significance of The Easter Story for Christians.</i></p>
Music	<p style="text-align: center;">Magical musical aquarium</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will respond to 'Aquarium' from The Carnival of the Animals. We will experiment with sound to create aquarium-inspired music, listen actively to Aquarium and refine our pieces and learn a sea-themed song.</i></p>
PSHE	<p style="text-align: center;">Citizenship</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will learn why rules are important, describe the needs of pets, babies and young children. We will also recognise similarities and differences between ourselves and others, identify groups we belong to and explain why voting is a fair way to make decisions.</i></p>
