English	<p style="text-align: center;">Writing</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Our writing for this half term will be based The Way Back Home by Oliver Jeffers. In this unit we will be learning how to use adjectives to describe nouns, use 'and' to join ideas in our sentences and use capital letters and full stops accurately.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Reading</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>We will be reading our Read Write Inc books within our phonics sessions. We will also be enjoying listening to lots of stories and enjoying reading for pleasure. We will learn to recite a poem by heart.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Grammar</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>This half term we will be focussing on using past and present tense.</i></p>
Mathematics	<p style="text-align: center;">Multiplication and division</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will be learning how to count forwards and backwards in 2s, 5s and 10s. We will also be recognising and adding equal groups and then making arrays. We will be making equal groups by grouping and sharing.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Fractions</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will be recognising and finding half and quarter of shapes and quantities.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Position and direction</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will be describing turns and position. We will also be learning about ordinal numbers.</i></p>
Science	<p style="text-align: center;">An introduction to plants</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will be identifying plants and their features and recalling some of the roles that flowering plant parts have. We will be naming some trees and their parts and identifying similarities and differences between deciduous and evergreen leaves. We will recall that seeds and bulbs come from plants and recognise that seeds need water for growth.</i></p>
Geography	<p style="text-align: center;">Routes and journeys</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will be learning about journeys made in our locality, the journeys we make to go on holiday and the journeys animals make. For our fieldwork this half term we will be making local journeys to assess it for safety and hazards.</i></p>
PE	<p style="text-align: center;">Yoga</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will be learning about mindfulness and body awareness. We will begin to learn poses and techniques that will help connect mind and body. We will look to improve well being by building strength, flexibility, co-ordination and balance.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Net and wall games</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will use and develop attacking and defending skills in net games such as using the ready position to defend and placement of the ball into space. We will use and develop our throwing, catching, tracking and hitting a ball skills. We will learn how to score points and play by the rules.</i></p>
Computing	<p style="text-align: center;">Animated stories</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will be learning how to create digital books using the 2Create a Story tool. We will learn how to work with images, text and sound. We will also learn how to animate simple objects.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Online Safety - perfect passwords</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>This half term we will learn how to create perfect passwords and how to keep our passwords safe.</i></p>
Art	<p style="text-align: center;">Sculpture – Making Birds</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will be learning about the relationship between drawing and making, 2d and 3d. We will be exploring how to transform materials into sculpture, moving from mark making to balance and structure.</i></p>
RE	<p style="text-align: center;">Judaism</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>The children will be learning about how celebrating Hanukkah makes Jews feel closer to God. We will be learning about the story of the Maccabees and the key traditions associated with the festival.</i></p>
Music	<p style="text-align: center;">Magical musical aquarium</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will respond to 'Aquarium' from The Carnival of the Animals. We will experiment with sound to create aquarium-inspired music, listen actively to Aquarium and refine our pieces and learn a sea-themed song.</i></p>
PSHE	<p style="text-align: center;">Economic Wellbeing</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will learn how we might get money and explain some different ways to keep money safe. We will discuss the role of banks and building societies and recognise that people may make different choices about spending or saving. We will explain that a range of jobs exist in and out of school and that different skills are needed for jobs.</i></p>
