English	<p style="text-align: center;">The Blue Umbrella</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this writing unit, children will learn to write a narrative and children will practice using direct speech.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Bill's new Frock</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Through this story, children will build upon their fluency and comprehension skills.</i></p>
Mathematics	<p style="text-align: center;">Fractions</p> <p style="text-align: center;">In this unit, children will learn to: order and compare fractions and understand equivalent fractions.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Length and perimeter</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Children will learn how to measure in mm, cm and m, add and subtract length, measure and calculate perimeter.</i></p>
History	<p style="text-align: center;">Roman Britain</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit children will explore who the Romans were, why they came to Britain, and how their invasion and settlement changed life for the people already living here. They will learn about Roman soldiers, everyday Roman life, key historical figures, and the lasting impact of Roman innovations—developing their skills in questioning evidence, understanding chronology, and explaining historical change.</i></p>
PE	<p style="text-align: center;">Dodgeball</p> <p style="text-align: center;">In this unit., pupils will improve key skills in dodgeball such as throwing, dodging and catching. Children will be given the opportunity to play games.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Fitness</p> <p style="text-align: center;">In this unit children will develop their overall fitness through activities that build stamina, strength, agility and coordination. They will learn how to challenge themselves safely, understand the importance of regular exercise, and work towards improving their personal performance across a range of physical tasks.</p>
Computing	<p style="text-align: center;">Email</p> <p style="text-align: center;">In this unit, children will learn how to structure, write and send their own emails.</p>
RE	<p style="text-align: center;">The Last Supper</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit children will be studying the days and events leading up to the death of Jesus.</i></p>
Music	<p style="text-align: center;">Sound Symmetry</p> <p style="text-align: center;">In this unit children will explore how music and visual patterns connect by creating sounds that mirror, repeat and respond to one another. They will develop their listening skills, experiment with rhythmic and melodic patterns, and work collaboratively to compose pieces that show balance, contrast and musical symmetry.</p>
PSHE	<p style="text-align: center;">Healthy Me</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit the children will be focusing how to keep themselves healthy.</i></p>
Art	<p style="text-align: center;">Shape and colour</p> <p style="text-align: center;">In this unit children will explore how artists use shape and colour to create mood, meaning and visual impact. They will experiment with arranging shapes, mixing colours and combining materials, developing their confidence in making creative choices and expressing ideas through bold, imaginative compositions.</p>
