Mathematics- Y4	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Decimals</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">In this unit the children will be taught to recognise and write decimal equivalents of any number of tenths or hundredths recognise and write decimal equivalents to 4 1 , 2 1 , 4 3; find the effect of dividing a one- or two-digit number by 10 and 100, identifying the value of the digits in the answer as ones, tenths and hundredths; round decimals with one decimal place to the nearest whole number; compare numbers with the same number of decimal places up to two decimal places; solve simple measure and money problems involving fractions and decimals to two decimal places.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Money</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">In this unit, children will learn to: recognize and covert between pounds and pence, add an subtract money and find change.</p>
History	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>What changed in Britain after the Anglo Saxon invasion?</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">In this unit the children will</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Explain how the Britons felt when the Romans left Britain.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Suggest reasons for the Anglo-Saxon invasion of Britain.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Name the key features of Anglo-Saxon settlements.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Identify changes and continuities in settlements from prehistoric Britain.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Make inferences about artefacts.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Describe how Anglo-Saxon beliefs changed.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Explain how missionaries spread Christianity.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Explain the threat the Vikings posed to the Anglo-Saxons.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Identify the qualities needed to be a monarch in 1066.</p>
PE	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Yoga</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">At the end of this unit, children will develop balance, strength and flexibility.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Hockey</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">The children will be learning about attacking and defending principles of invasion games.</p>
Computing	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Sound Stories</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">In this unit children will explore the following;</p> <p style="text-align: center;">To understand what makes audiobooks effective and identify the key features that make them engaging.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">To plan and write a script for an engaging audiobook.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">To record clear narration and add sound effects to an audiobook.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">To edit, improve and finalise an audiobook using recording and sound design tools.</p>
Art	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Festival Feasts</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Children explore artists who make sculptures of food, working at unexpected scales, working in a sketchbook to make visual notes to consolidate their experience. Children then further develop drawing skills by drawing from still imagery and from life.</p>
RE	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Hinduism</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">children will be learning about karma, samsara and moksha.</p>
