English	<p>Screen Use Children will study a balanced argument based on screen use for children. Then will then create an independent balanced argument about computer dependency.</p> <p>Street Child Children will develop their reading skills and responses through the study of this book.</p>
Maths	<p>Shape In this unit, children will learn how to estimate, measure and classify angles in a range of 2d shapes.</p> <p>Position and Direction In this unit, children will taught how to identify and plot coordinates. They will also develop their translation, reflection and symmetry skills.</p> <p>Decimals In this unit, children learn how to add, subtract, multiply and divide decimals.</p>
Geography	<p>Biomes and Vegetation Belts Children will explore the layers of the rainforest, locate the world's deserts and discover the animals of the savannah.</p>
Science	<p>Forces and Space: Unbalanced Forces Children will learn about gravity, air resistance, water resistance, friction, leaver pulleys and gears.</p>
PE	<p>Yoga The children develop their yoga skills and create their own flow that they can teach to their peers.</p> <p>Athletics Children will develop running, jumping and throwing skills through individual and team events.</p> <p>Swimming Children will attend a block of swimming lessons with the goal of confidently swimming 25m.</p>
Computing	<p>3d modelling In this unit, children will use Purple Mash to learn how to create 3d models using technology.</p>
Online Safety	<p>Be A Super Digital Citizen Children will reflect on the characteristics that make someone an upstanding digital citizen, recognise what cyberbullying is and show ways to be an upstander.</p>
Art	<p>Architecture: Dream Big and Small Children will enjoy exploring the responsibilities architects have to design us a better world. They will then make their own architectural model.</p>
RE	<p>Hinduism In this unit, children will explore the question – How do Hindus show they commitment to God?</p>
Music	<p>Clarinet Children will be learning how to play the clarinet, read, compose and perform music.</p>
PSHE	<p>Citizenship In this unit, children will explore their own right and responsibilities, understand what happens when the law is broken, know how to contribute to the community and explore the government.</p>
French	<p>Scenes de Plages Children will develop their French speaking, vocabulary, writing and listening skills based around the beach.</p>
