English	<p style="text-align: center;">Writing</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Our writing for this half term will be based Little Red Riding Hood by Lari Don. In this unit we will be learning how to use adjectives to describe nouns, use 'and' to join ideas in our sentences and use capital letters and full stops accurately.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Reading</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>We will be reading our Read Write Inc books within our phonics sessions. We will also be enjoying listening to lots of stories and enjoying reading for pleasure. We will learn to recite a poem by heart.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Grammar</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>This half term we will be revisiting nouns, verbs and adjectives.</i></p>
Mathematics	<p style="text-align: center;">Place Value</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will be counting, partitioning and comparing numbers from 50 to 100.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Money</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will be recognising coins and notes and learn how to count in coins (2s, 5s and 10s).</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Time</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will be learning about days, months and durations of time. We will learn to tell the time to the hour and the half hour.</i></p>
Science	<p style="text-align: center;">Investigating science through stories</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will be revising and building on our previous science learning. We will be looking at materials and animals again through lots of different investigations.</i></p>
History	<p style="text-align: center;">Explorers</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will be learning about explorers. We will focus on Christopher Columbus and Matthew Henson. We will look at how exploration has changes and what we can do to remember explorers.</i></p>
PE	<p style="text-align: center;">Athletics</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will be learning how to run, jump and throw.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Striking and fielding games</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will use and develop attacking and defending skills in striking and fielding games such as rounders and cricket. We will use and develop our throwing, catching, tracking and hitting a ball skills. We will learn how to score points and play by the rules.</i></p>
Computing	<p style="text-align: center;">Coding</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will be learning how to code using the block coding tool, 2Code. We will explore simple instructions and relate this to code blocks. By the end of this unit, we will be able to make a simple program.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Online Safety - perfect passwords</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>This half term we will learn how to create perfect passwords and how to keep our passwords safe.</i></p>
Art	<p style="text-align: center;">Sculpture – Making Birds</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will be learning about the relationship between drawing and making, 2d and 3d. We will be exploring how to transform materials into sculpture, moving from mark making to balance and structure.</i></p>
DT	<p style="text-align: center;">Bring on breakfast</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>In this unit we will be tasting different breakfast products to help us plan, make and evaluate our own breakfast dish. We will be developing the skills to safely use a range of basic cooking equipment.</i></p>
RE	<p style="text-align: center;">Big Question – How do different religions and non-religions celebrate birth?</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>The children will be learning about how different religions and non-religions celebrate the arrival of a new baby.</i></p>

We will experiment with sound to create aquarium-inspired music, listen actively to Aquarium and refine our pieces and learn a sea-themed song.</i></p>
