In Literacy we will be focusing on the classic fairy tale "Little Red Riding Hood" and learning about a variety of different writing genres inspired by the story e.g. lists & letters

In R,E, we will be learning about "Good News" and how Jesus lived his life as good news. We will also have a whole school value of 'Thankfulness' where we will be learning about what this looks and feels like.

In topic we will be learning about the geography of our school. We will be learning the purpose of maps and to create our own maps. We will also be using maps of our school and local area to help us to do research.



We will be continuing to use our Power Maths scheme of work. This term we will be looking at numbers to 10 and addition and subtraction strategies we have learnt so far. It is really important the children know how to form their numbers to 10 so any support at home will really help!



In science this half term we are learning about the human body. We will be learning about the main body parts such as head, arms, legs, elbows, etc. We will also be exploring the 5 senses through different experiments. Throughout the year, we will be observing the tree in our playground. We will watch the changes to it throughout the different seasons.
