

Personal Social and Emotional Development

We will be focussing on becoming more independent and managing our own self-care, putting on our own coats, using the toilet and washing our hands.

We will be continuing thinking about different feelings, but will be extended from happy and sad to more emotions - angry, excited, tired, scared etc.

In Collective Worship our value is trust. We will be thinking about what trust means and the people who we can trust around us.

'Literacy

In phonics we will be continuing to learn the Set 1 sounds.

We will be focussing on our letter formation, especially the letters in our name.

Children will be identifying initial sounds in words and starting to hear the final and medial sound.



Communication and Language

We will be:

Reading stories about our topic

Talking about familiar people and places

Circle times taking turns when speaking

Listening to our friends' ideas

Putting our hands up when we want to talk during carpet time.



'Physical Development

In PE we will be looking at different ways of travelling.

We will be revising the fundamental movement skills that children have already acquired:

- rolling • crawling • walking • jumping
- running • hopping • skipping • climbing.
