
Please do remember to send your child in with a coat and ideally a water bottle. Thank you.

English

Writing will draw upon 'The Diary of a Killer Cat' which is a fun text written from the cat's perspective. Initially we will focus on remembering and recording a sentence accurately. Then we will practise using verbs and adverbs before developing sentence structure using conjunctions and prepositions. We will then revise how to edit work. Once



accuracy has been improved, they will use their skills to write diary entries in role as a character from the text.

Topic

Last half-term the children learnt about early settlement in Stockport which focussed on the Stone Age. This half-term the focus will continue to be on early settlement in Stockport and will move onto the Bronze Age and Iron Age. Their learning will concentrate on the settlement in Mellor

and how people have used the pottery and other artefacts found there in an effort to build up a picture of the past.



PSHE

This half term our work will centre on grief. We will be learning how to recognise and name emotions and also to recognise the difference between those feelings that are pleasant and those that are unpleasant. We will then move

Year 3

Science

Our focus this half-term will be rocks and the children will be learning about the properties of rocks - whether they are all the same and if not then how they can be categorised. They will also be thinking about how different types of rocks are suited to different purposes. Following on we will also look at what fossils are and how they are made before finally looking at the composition of soil.



This term we will continue to benefit from games sessions delivered by specialist sports coaches. Class adults will work alongside to support and encourage the children.

Tuesday - Meg (Primary Reds, MUtd) will work on physical skills and teamwork. The children really enjoy these sessions so it is great they have the opportunity to carry on developing their capabilities.


Friday - Kyle will develop skills in a range of sports. Skills will then be applied within a match. (Educational Sports Coaches)
