Personal Social and Emotional Development

We will be continuing to work on becoming more independent and managing our own self-care, getting undressed and dressed for PE, zipping up our own coats and using the toilet and washing our hands. We will be continuing thinking about different feelings and how to moderate their own feelings socially and emotionally, recognising how our actions can impact someone else's feelings.

In Collective Worship our value is Justice. We will be thinking about what justice means and how we can make sure that we are fair.

Literacy

In phonics we will be focussing on learning to blend words to read, some children are now reading so we will be working on fluency and understanding to become secure and confident readers.

We will be working hard to get our name writing perfect this half term.







Understanding the World

In our topic this half term we will be learning about minibeasts and plants. We will be understanding the key features of the life cycle of a plant and an animal. We will be planting our own seeds and learning how best to care for growing plants. We will begin to understand the need to respect and care for the natural environment and all living things. We will be learning about the season of Spring and the effects of the changing seasons on the world around us.

Physical Development

In PE in nursery we will be catching and throwing, scarves, bean bags and balls.

Reception will be further developing and refining their ball skills including: throwing, catching, kicking, passing, batting, and aiming.

Reception require a PE kit to ensure they are well prepared for Year 1, we will be practising getting undressed and dressed and looking after our own belongings



We will be exploring simple and complex patterns and learning about height and weight.

Reception children will be thinking about subtraction within 10 and continuing our learning using the part whole model.

We will be practising our subitising skills and learning our number bonds to 10.
