This half term we will be exploring the question - "Why is Jesus inspiring to some people?" This will involve lots of discussions.

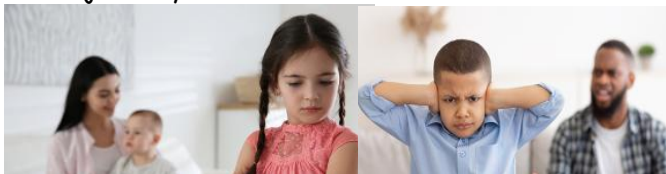
### Collective Worship

### Maths

**Year 3** are working with adding three 1 digit numbers together mentally. To help them with this, they have been using their number bonds to 10, doubles and near doubles. They have also found out it does not matter which order the numbers go in.

**Year 4** are practising column addition with 3 digit numbers. This has given them chance to revise place value and they have been setting out calculations independently to show what they have learnt.

### Topic

This year, we will be teaching History, Geography, DT and Art as a project week. Our focus this half term will be about Stockport.



### Science

This half term, our science topic will be 'Living things and their habitats.' We will look at changes environment threatening life, grouping living things and much more.
