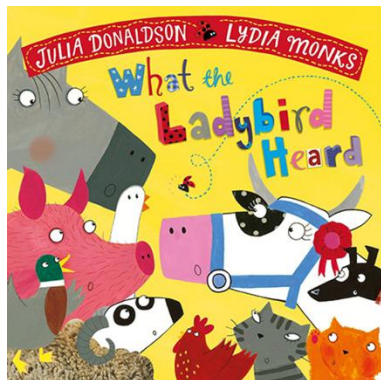


Spring | Year 1



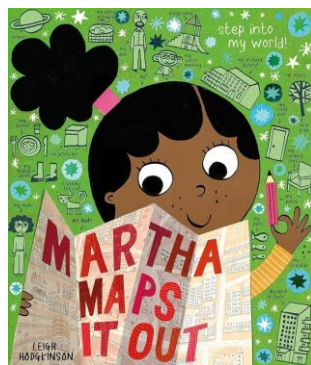
Maths

Topic

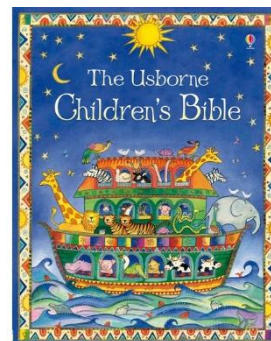
In geography this half term we are learning about where we live, where the UK is in the world and how we are made up of four different countries. We will continue to learn about how maps help us to understand our world.
