




<h3>Literacy</h3> <p>The Author that we will be focussing on this half term is Anthony Browne.</p> <p>We will be writing a narrative, to re-tell Willy's story to our peers, but we will be changing key parts of the story.</p> <p>We will also be writing a diary entry as Hannah, to recount events.</p>  	<h3>Maths</h3> <h4>Money</h4> <p>In maths we will be starting our money unit. We will learn to:</p> <p>Recognise and use symbols for pounds (£) and pence (p).</p> <p>Combine amounts to make a particular value.</p> <p>Find different combinations of coins that equal the same amounts of money.</p> <p>Solve simple problems in a practical context involving addition and subtraction of money of the same unit, including giving change.</p> 	<h3>Science</h3> <h4>Use of everyday materials</h4> <p>We will be identifying the different materials that things are made from. We will identify how materials are used in school and the suitability of these materials.</p> <p>We will learn about the properties of materials and how they behave also thinking about if objects could change shape depending on the material that is used.</p> 	
<h3>Project Week</h3> <p><u>Is the whole of the UK the same as where I live?</u></p> <h4>Geography</h4> <p>Use an atlas and a globe to find the UK.</p> <p>Know the four seas that surround the UK.</p> <p>Know key features of the four countries in the UK (capital city, weather, monuments, location)</p> <p>Use simple compass directions (NSEW) to explain places on a map i.e. Scotland in the North.</p> <h4>Art</h4> <p><u>Andy Goldsworthy</u></p> <p>We will be researching the artist Andy Goldsworthy and designing and making a sculpture using natural materials.</p>	<h3>Spring 1 – Year 2</h3>   <h3>Anthony Browne</h3>	<h4>PSHE</h4> <h5>Relationships</h5> <p>Following our 1decision scheme we will be exploring relationships.
