

Literacy

The book we will be focussing on this half term is *Meerkat Mail*.

We will be adding suffixes to spell some words correctly in our writing (e.g. -ment, -ness, -ful, -less, -ly)

Making simple additions, revisions and corrections to their own writing by: evaluating their writing

Using commas in a list

Using co-ordination (e.g. or / and / but) and some subordination (e.g. when / if / that / because) to join clauses.

Maths

Addition and Subtraction & Money

In maths we will be securing our addition and subtraction knowledge. Adding and subtracting numbers including: • A two-digit number and ones • A two-digit number and tens • Two two-digit numbers • Adding three one-digit numbers and solving missing number problems.

Then we will be continuing our money unit.

Finding different combinations of coins that equal the same amounts of money.

Solving simple problems in a practical context involving addition and subtraction of money of the same unit, including giving change.

Science

Plants

We will be thinking about what bulbs and seeds need to germinate and what plants need to stay healthy. We will learn about the life cycle of a plant and where is best to plant flowers.



We will then plant our own seeds to observe how they grow.




