### Maths

#### Year 3

We will be looking at number lines. We will apply their understanding of the relative value of numbers to place numbers on a number line and then estimate what value a mark on the number line could be representing. Then we will move on to ordering numbers.

#### Year 4

After completing our work on negative numbers, we will learn about Roman numerals. Once that is completed, we will be looking at written methods for addition and subtraction. This will allow us to apply our place value learning from last half-term.

### Topic


