Collective Worship


Our School's value this half term during collective worship is Justice.

Writing

Year 4: We will be basing our writing around the book 'The Fox Who Stole the Moon' by N. G. K. A review describes it as "A book of true magic. It instils hope, imagination and curiosity" so we will be able to have lots of fun as it is used to inspire their writing in different genre. Their first piece will be a diary entry in the role of one of the characters and then a newspaper report.



Year 5: The children will be spending the next 2 weeks looking at the book 'Traction Man'. We will be focusing on our use of grammar and sentence structure to write a simple version of this story making sure we are accurate with our grammar, punctuation and spelling throughout.

Year 5 - We will begin this half term by looking at written methods for addition and subtraction. We will then move on to multiplication and division - multiplying a number by 10, 100 and 1,000, scaling known facts, and doubling and halving.




