The book we will be focussing on this half term is *The Secret of Black Rock*.



The fiction focus will be writing to narrate and entertain.
The non-fiction focus will be writing to inform.

Maths

Following our maths scheme *First 4 Maths*, we will be finishing off our addition and subtraction unit and moving onto our multiplication and division unit.

In these units' children will be adding and subtracting two two-digit numbers and three one-digit numbers and recalling and using multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times tables, including recognising odd and even numbers.

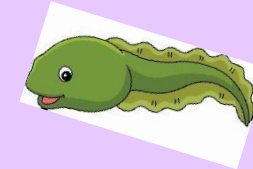
They will be calculating mathematical statements for multiplication and division within the multiplication tables and write them using the multiplication (\times), division (\div) and equals ($=$) signs.

Being reliable and doing what is expected or required of you.

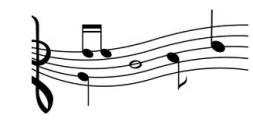

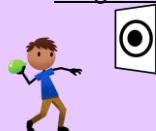
