We will be focusing on working collaboratively and safely. We will be learning how to travel in different ways, create shapes with our bodies, and will learn to roll.



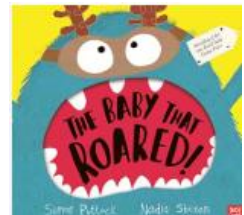
English

This half term we will have begun by focusing on ensuring that the children are able to count sets of objects accurately.

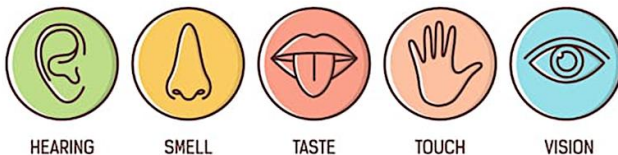
We will then move on to one more and one less, and comparing and ordering numbers.
