Endings and new beginnings can be emotional for children. Offer reassurance and acknowledge their feelings to help them adjust more easily.

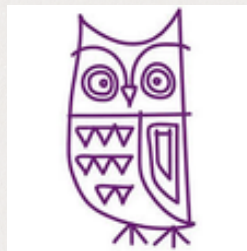

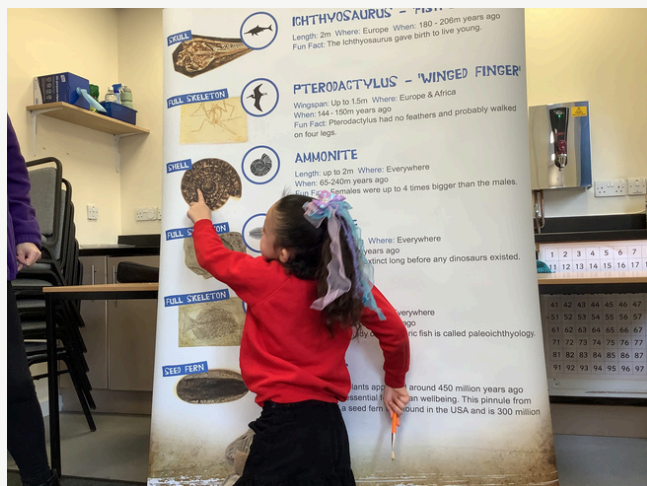

This week's topic- Help your child manage separations and goodbyes
It's completely normal for children to feel anxious about separating from their parent or carer. New situations, people, and places can feel overwhelming, and when children are worried or frightened, they naturally want to stay close to the adults they trust. This can make goodbyes difficult, especially during school drop-offs or when leaving them with someone new.

This Parenting Smart tip explores why separations can be challenging and offers simple, supportive ways to help your child cope. It highlights the importance of understanding what might be behind their fears, offering reassurance, and giving them calm, focused one-to-one time. The article also explains how predictable goodbye routines, comforting objects, and managing your own emotions can help children feel safer and more confident. Over time, these small, consistent steps can make separations easier for both you and your child.
