Year 4 Autumn 1

English

We will begin by looking at narrative stories focusing on the text A firework maker's daughter. We will then be writing and performing play scripts based on the same novel.

Maths

We will begin by looking at the place value of numbers up to 10,000, partitioning and representing them in different ways.

We will then move onto: adding and subtracting of any integers, using both the formal written method and mental strategies too.

Science

Our science this half term is electricity. We will be learning about electrical circuits and their components and how to stay safe around electricity. We will also be looking at sustainability and how to use electricity responsibly.

R.E

In R.E. this term we will be looking at David and the Psalms and what worship is. We will discuss David's character and why he was chosen to be a king.

History

In History we will be learning about ancient civilisations such as the Egyptians and the Mayans. We will look at how they began, their buildings, number systems and trade.

Computing

In computing we will be improving our digital literacy as well as creating digital surveys and analysing the data.
