

Curriculum Map

Year 6 Autumn 1 2023-2024

English

We will begin by looking at mystery stories focusing on the text, *The Curious Case of the Stolen Show*. During this topic we will write our own mystery story for the school library focusing on grabbing the readers attention

Maths

We will begin by looking at the place value of numbers up to 10,000,000, multiplying and dividing by powers of 10, rounding and negative numbers.

We will then move onto: adding and subtracting of any integers; factors and multiples; prime, square and cubed numbers; short and long multiplication and then short division.

Science

In science we will be looking at electricity and we will learn the main circuit symbols and use these to draw circuit diagrams. We will plan and conduct an investigation linked to voltage. We will make predictions, decide which variables to control and decide how to record data. We will also learn how major discoveries led to the widespread use of electricity and how electricity has changed over time.

R.E

In R.E. this term we will be looking at the idea that life is a journey and what it means to make that journey as a Christian. We will also be looking at other religions and the concept of undertaking a religious pilgrimage.

Geography

Consolidating on our knowledge so far about the world. We will be researching an area of interest to us and looking at the location of it by identifying it on various maps. We will look at the human and physical features of it and compare it to the U.K.

Computing

In computing we will be investigating codes and understanding that there are many different types of secret codes. We will be identifying the importance of having a secure passwords and how these can be hacked. In computing history, we will be looking into the importance of Bletchley Park to the WW2 war effort.

Art

During art this half term we will be looking at various patterns found on fabrics and creating our own. We will use paints to create our patterns on fabric to create our own garment.

French

In French we will be looking at sports in French. We will be able to accurately pronounce the name of sports and construct simple sentences to say whether we like a sport or not. We will look at the correct form of 'aller' meaning to go and use this in written and oral sentences. We will also learn the basic rules of pétanque.

This half term we will be learning the skills of football and orienteering. Focusing on the skills needed and how to work as a team.
