



Curriculum Map

Year R Spring 1 2023-2024



Each half term your child's learning will be linked to a topic. This half term the topic is 'People Who Help Us'. The curriculum map is divided up into the 7 areas of learning in EYFS and R.E. It informs you what your child will be learning over the half term.

Communication and Language

We will be recapping on the skills needed to be a good listener who is ready to learn. We will also be learning about the roles of different occupations.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will use circle time to discuss our ambitions and how we can support and help each other achieve them. We will learn about safety and how to keep ourselves safe.

Physical Development

We will be experimenting with different ways of moving; negotiating space, adjusting speed and changing direction.

We will be discussing tackling new challenges and having a go at activities that we feel less confident with.

Literacy

This half term we will be reading fairy tales. We will be writing questions, making posters and trying to write simple sentences independently.

Mathematics

We will be counting numbers 0-20 and using everyday language related to money. We will be exploring weight, describing objects as heavier or lighter and investigating capacity using describing containers as full or empty.

Understanding the World

We will be investigating how to make vehicles move this half term. We will be exploring materials and textures. During Tree Top Tuesday we will be exploring signs of Winter.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be creating models of vehicles to support our learning of our topic. We will be acting out the roles of people who help us in our community during this half term in our role play corner.

Religious Education

The focus in R.E. this half term we will be listening to some of the stories that Jesus told. We will be acting some of the stories out and retelling them.
