Year 4 Spring1 2023-2024



English

This half term, we will be learning to write limerick poems, which require knowledge of rhyming words and syllables. Before moving on to writing exciting and engaging stories.

Our class shared story for the half term will be George's Marvellous Medicine! One of Mr T's favourites!

Maths

This half term, we will be learning to identify factor pairs, multiply and divide by 10 and 100, multiply 3 digit numbers by single digit numbers, as well as identifying the area and perimeter of different rectangular shapes. Mrs Rigby will also be in class, teaching everyone how to tell the time accurately.

Religious Education

In this unit we will be deepening the children's understanding of Jesus, who he was, his teaching and behaviour.

We will use the events covered in the stories in this unit to illustrate and emphasise the Christian belief that Jesus is the Son of God; that he was God and man, both human and divine.

Science

We will be introduced to the main body parts associated with the digestive system, for example: mouth, tongue, teeth, oesophagus, stomach, and small and large intestine, and explore questions that help them to understand their special functions.

History

In History we will be learning about the Ancient Egyptians. We will be learning about the Gods and Goddesses, royalty and how the Nile was used amongst other things.

P.E.

One of our P.E. sessions will be taken up with our exciting sessions at forest school – we can't wait!

Our other P.E. session with Mr O'Brien, will be something different that year 4 have not experienced before. They will be learning how to play Boccia.

French

- To understand and respond to simple classroom instructions.
- To name school bag objects and recognise if they are masculine or feminine. To read and understand short sentences
- To ask and answer a question about something you have or do not have

In this unit, the children will explore the work of the artist Adriana Brinsmead-Stockham. They will build on their drawing skills by experimenting with a range of different media. The children will build on their painting skills by colour mixing and experimenting with different textures and effects before creating their final piece.

Computing

In computing we will learning about internet safety.

We will learn about internet searching, fact, fiction and opinions online, the positives and negatives of time spent online, as well as respectful and disrespectful online behaviour.
