

Curriculum Map

Year 6 Spring 2 2023-2024



English

We will be looking at fantasy stories and using some great examples to write our own character and setting descriptions as well as a short story. We will also be looking at explanation texts and writing our own explanation linked to our science topic.

Maths

In maths we are learning about decimals. We will learn about place value to 3 decimal places and how to multiply and divide with decimals. We will also be learning about fractions and percentages and the relationship between them. Our final topic for the half term will be area, perimeter and volume.

Science

Our science this half term is evolution and inheritance. We learn about fossils and how scientists use them to learn how living things have changed over time. We will also learn that living things produce offspring and that some characteristics are inherited. Finally, we will identify how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment and that adaptation may lead to sevolution.

R.E

We will be looking at the questions, 'Who was Jesus?' and 'Who is Jesus?' from their own point of view and the views of others in the past and today.

We will be increasing our understanding of who Jesus was and is according to the Bible and investigating who Jesus was according to the followers of major world faiths and those with non-religious world views.

Art

We will be looking at a wide range of mediums including: photography, pen line portrait, textured mark making, paint blending and digital layering techniques. Eventually, bringing them all together to create a final piece about themselves.

Computing

We will be learning how to record sounds and add in sound effects which we will link to our music and art projects. We will also be learning about the world's first computers and how they have changed and shaped the world we live in now.

Music

In music we will explore the concept of 'identity' and we will try out different ways of making our own music, while exploring the work of some of the most influential women in music over the last 100 years. We will create our own compositions which explore and express our identities.

Geography

We will learn about how the UK is organised into countries, counties, cities and towns as well as learning about the human and physical features of Great Britain. We will look at our town of Padiham and answer the question, 'Why do people come to Padiham?'

P.E.

Our P.E. this half term will cover the invasion game of rugby. We will learn how to play small games of rugby and how to pass and score. Our second P.E. topic is gymnastics. We will be building upon our skills from the Autumn term and developing techniques and skills to create our own gymnastics routines.
