English

This half term we will be delving into the world of Classic Poetry. We will be learning and adapting the poem by Edward Lear, 'The Owl and the Pussycat'. We will look at generating effective verbs and features of poetry.

Then we will look at The Owl who was afraid of the dark and adapting the setting to write our own chapter.

Maths

This half term we will continue to deepen our understanding of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

We will do this through working with money, measurement and towards the end of the half term, fractions.

We will also start to look at time.

Science/ Geography

In Geography we will be looking at hot and cold countries. We will be discovering the seven continents and oceans and locating these on the map.

We will also be researching and exploring habitats and microhabitats. We will look into what animals and plants thrive in different areas and why.

RE

This half term we will be exploring Easter—How do symbols help us to understand the story? Why does Easter matter to Christians?

DT

In DT, we will be researching, designing and creating our own puppets. These will be based on the texts that we are doing in English. The children will work on their sewing and joining skills.

PSHE

In PHSE we will continue to look at keeping ourselves safe and relationships with others. We will look at our rights and responsibilities including our right to feel safe.

Music

This half term in Music we will be looking at the style of Reggae. We will be looking at different rhythms and the dimensions of reggae music.

Computing

In computing this half term, Class 2 will be looking at keeping ourselves safe online.

PE

This half term we will only have PE on a Thursday due to Forest School. Monday's will focus on fielding and striking.
