



Curriculum Map

Year R Autumn 1 2025-2026



Each half term your child's learning will be linked to a topic. This half term the topic is 'All About Me'. The curriculum map is divided up into the 7 areas of learning in EYFS and R.E. It informs you what your child will be learning over the half term.

Communication and Language

We will be practising our listening skills and learning our school routines. We will also be learning how to take turns.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will use circle time to promote our class expectations and reflect on our behaviour and friendships. We will be encouraging each other to speak confidently in front of our peers.

Physical Development

We will be focusing on activities to develop both fine and gross motor skills. Strengthening the muscles in our hands and arms is especially important as it helps prepare for writing. We will use both indoor and outdoor activities, as well as our P.E. sessions, to build strength and coordination in the rest of our bodies too.

Literacy

This half term we will be reading traditional tales, nursery rhymes and poems. We will be practising our phonics and writing skills.

Mathematics

We will be practising our 1:1 counting and working on our number recognition. We will use this to extend our number knowledge, order and compare numbers.

Understanding the World

We will be learning about our environment this half term. We will discuss how we are similar and different. We will be observing how the season change as we head into Autumn.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be learning new songs with actions. We will be looking at ourselves using mirrors to draw self-portraits. We will also be collaging pictures and exploring different materials.

Religious Education

This half term will be thinking about how we are special. We will talk about how God makes each one of us different and special.
