English

This half term in English we will be looking at the story The Crow's Tale to write an innovated story. We will also be looking at instructions to write our own instructions and finally we will learn the classic poem, 'Twas the Night Before Christmas and perform it.

Maths

In Maths, we will continue looking at addition and subtraction, first by subtracting and adding ones then moving onto two digit numbers. We will spend a lot of time focusing on addition and subtraction with exchange, crossing ten.

Science

We will be looking at sustainability this half term with a focus on recycling. We will look at what can be recycled, what happens if we don't recycle and how we can all play a part in recycling.

RE

This half term we will complete our unit on The Bible. We will then be looking at why the birth of Jesus was good news. We will look at how and why that good news was spread and if it is still good news today.

DT

We have a very exciting DT topic this half term as we research, design and create pizzas. We will start of by researching current pizzas and in particular what makes them good. We will then design our own pizzas based on what we like or dislike. We will then get to the exciting part of creating our own pizzas.

Geography

In Geography we will be using fieldwork skills to answer the question, where is Padiham? We will look at human and physical features, learn how to read a map and compass points and we will have a go at drawing our own maps.

Music

It's Christmas! This half term we will continue to develop our appraisal skills. We will listen to pieces of music and establish what instruments we can hear. We will then learn and practise a range of Christmas songs, ending with a final performance in our Nativity.

Computing

Coding—In this unit, we will learn about collision detection and timers. We will develop an understanding that different objects have different properties and use this to create a program.

PE

We are continuing with our swimming lessons this half term and will be looking at ball skills in our school PE lessons.
