



# Curriculum Map

## Year 3 Spring 1 2025 - 2026



### English

This half term we take a trip to the stone age and write our own story based on a theme.

Spelling remains a big focus in Class 3, along with handwriting.

Additionally we will have a discussion based text around the stone age.

### Maths

We will continue working on mental arithmetic and times tables daily. During Maths lessons, we will continue to learn about multiplication and division and will then move on to length and perimeter.

### R.E

How did Jesus change our lives?

Children will explore stories from the disciples and investigate how lives were changed. Alongside the challenges of being a follower of Jesus.

### Science

A new topic for the children in Class 3, who will be investigating, exploring and experimenting with different types of rock.

We will be using our working scientifically skills to create an investigation, ask and answer questions and draw conclusions.

### History

We will be looking at the mysteries of Stonehenge comparing the stone age to the iron age.

We will create our own Stonehenge, ask and answer questions and conclude on our own opinions about what Stone henge is all about.

### P.E

On a Tuesday we will be learning about invasion games such as dodgeball.

This term Class 3 will be swimming every Wednesday morning.

### Music

This term begins with activities designed to help children identify and describe the ingredients (dimensions) that make up music. The children will explore instruments, associated with different countries and use this knowledge to create simple accompaniments to songs such as We're Going Round The World.

### Art

Looking at the artist Franz Anthony.

An exciting new project that will enable the children to critique his work and mirror their own sketches based on his art. Finishing with a printing of their fossil.

### Computing

The children will learn to understand and use branching databases.
