



# Curriculum Map

# Year 6 Spring 2 2025-2026



## English

We will begin this half term by continuing with our work on Macbeth. We will then be looking at biographies, linking our writing to our Science work looking at famous scientists. We will finally move onto mystery stories focussing on the text Room 13 by Robert Swindells.

## Maths

We will begin the half term by looking at calculating with decimals before moving on to fractions, decimals and percentages and how they link together. We will then look at area, perimeter and volume before finishing the half-term with statistics.

## R.E—Jesus

In this unit, the children the opportunity to stand back and consider 'Who was Jesus?' and 'Who is Jesus?' from their own point of view and the views of others in the past and today. They will learn about the way that Jesus is viewed in other faiths.

## Science—Evolution and Inheritance

In this unit, the children will find out more about how living things on earth have changed over time. They will be introduced to the idea that characteristics are passed from parents to their offspring. They will learn that variation in offspring over time can make animals

## Computing—3D Modelling

In this unit, the children will explore and develop simple 3D models using CAD software. They will plan, design and begin creating packaging to meet a design brief then refine, assemble and evaluate the finished packaging prototype.

## P.E

In P.E. this half term, we will cover invasion games where we will be learning to play rugby. Our other P.E. focus will be gymnastics.

## Art—Digital Media

In this unit, the children will learn about the artist Romero Britto and look at his work. They will explore a wide range of mediums including: photography, pen line portrait illustration and layering techniques; eventually bringing all these things together for their final piece.

## PSHE– Rights and Respect

In this unit, the children will explore how people present themselves online and how social media can affect self-esteem. They will learn about environmentally sustainable living and the advantages and disadvantages of different ways of saving money.

## French—Our Precious Planet

In this unit, pupils will learn to describe key environmental challenges in their local area and develop their awareness of sustainability. They will deliver a short presentation, using all the phrases and vocabulary they have learnt.
