



Curriculum Map

Year R Spring 2 2025-2026



Each half term your child's learning will be linked to a topic. This half term the topic is 'Watch me grow'. The curriculum map is divided up into the 7 areas of learning in EYFS and R.E. It informs you what your child will be learning over the half term.

Communication and Language

We will be recapping on the skills needed to be a good listener who is ready to learn. We will be answering questions about different stories and characters.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

In this unit, children will learn how to care for special people, friends, and their home, explore ways to help the environment, and begin to understand money, including how to use it safely and save it.

Physical Development

We will be experimenting with different ways of moving; negotiating space, adjusting speed and changing direction. We will be exploring different ways to throw and roll a ball.

Literacy

This half term we will be reading 'Food Fight' and 'Where does my food come from?'. We will be performing poems, re-telling stories and writing simple sentences independently.

Mathematics

We will be representing 9 and 10 in different ways, exploring odd and even numbers and finding doubles. We will be recognising and naming 3D shapes and looking at patterns in the environment.

Understanding the World

We will be investigating light, dark and shadows and how different materials can have different effects. We will also look at the changing seasons and signs of spring. We will also look how we keep our bodies healthy.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be combing resources to create pictures, models and patterns using 3D shapes. We will also be making mothers day cards.

Religious Education

In this unit, children will explore the Easter story, including Palm Sunday, the Last Supper, Good Friday, and Easter Sunday. They will learn that Christians believe Jesus died because God loves everyone and rose again, retell the story, identify Easter symbols, and reflect on the emotions in the story and their own experiences of love.
