



# Curriculum Map

# Year 6 Summer 1 2025-2026



## English

We will begin this half term by look at biography writing before moving onto our next unit which is based on the poem 'The Lion and Albert' by Marriot Edgar. We will use the poem to produce different genres of writing including flashback stories, diaries and letters.

## Maths

We will begin the half term by continuing to look at shape, including angles before moving on to co-ordinates, translating and reflecting shape. We then be looking at the areas of ratio and algebra.

## R.E—What is the importance of Ascension and Pentecost to Christians?

In this unit, the children will develop their understanding of the Christian stories of Ascension and Pentecost. They will retell these stories and learn how they link to Christian beliefs. The children will also explore how these events help Christians think about questions about God and the impact of the Holy Spirit on people's lives.

## Science—Sustainability

In this unit, the children will develop a deeper understanding of the current issues around sustainability and climate change. They will Identify that they have a role to play in creating a more sustainable future for themselves and others and think of ways to make a positive impact on their local and wider environments.

## Computing—Coding

In this unit, the children will develop their understanding of how to use the tools and features in 2Code to create simple programs. They will explore different ways of generating user input to make their programs interactive. They will also use flowcharts and program design documents to plan, test and fix their work before creating their own text-based adventure game.

## P.E

In P.E. this half term, the children will be working on striking and fielding games with a focus on cricket.

We will also be looking at invasion games with a focus on football.

## Music—Ukulele

In this unit, the children will continue to learn to play the ukulele. Pupils to learn with weekly sessions from a Lancashire School for Music tutor. Culminating in a performance to the school and parents.



## Geography- Climate Change—Renewable and Non-Renewable Energy

In this unit, the children will learn about the mix of energy that is used in the U.K. They will find out more about renewable and non-renewable energy and the effect that energy production and use can have on our climate.
