



Curriculum Map

Year 5 Summer 2 2025-2026



English

In English, we will be looking at texts from different cultures. Our focus text will Journey to the river sea by Eva Ibbotson.

We will write a variety of different text types, focussing on character descriptions before writing our own adapted version of the story.

Maths

In maths this half term, we will be continuing our work on angles and shapes. We will then move to looking more closely at decimal numbers and calculating with them before finishing the year with negative numbers and measures.

R.E

In R.E. this half term, the children will learn that Christians believe that through the death and resurrection of Jesus we have the promise of living forever with God (eternal life), they will understand that Christians believe that when you die your spirit goes to be with God in heaven.

Science

Our science topic this half term is Animals including Humans.

In this unit, the children will describe how humans change and grow through the different stages of their life and before they are born.

History

In History this half term, we will be studying the Islamic Golden Age. We will investigate where Baghdad was built and why. We will look into the House of Wisdom and finish up by looking at the destruction of Baghdad.

P.E

P.E. will continue to take place on Wednesdays and Thursdays. The children will be working on tennis and rugby therefore continuing to develop their teamwork and ball skills.

French

In French this half term, we will be learning key vocabulary related to objects, subjects and prepositional language. We will be using the pronouns *il* and *elle* alongside using comparative adjectives.

Art

In this unit, the children will explore the work of the sculptor Courtney Mattison. They will build on their drawing skills by using viewfinders to select small areas and enlarging them using a range of media to draw and colour. The children will then take these drawings and create a 3D sculpture working collaboratively to recreate work by Courtney Mattison. The children will use a range of painting techniques to create waves and use these painted waves to create a collage.

Computing

In computing this half term, we will be looking at word processing. We will learn to produce a word document from scratch. Type up and edit our typing, before finally printing our work.
