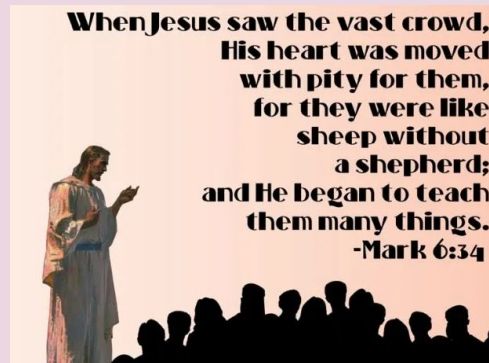

Year Two—Thursday 18th June 3:00pm

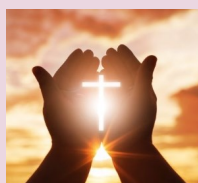
Year Three—Monday 6th July 3:00pm
