Statutory Assessments

During the summer term, there are a few assessment dates for families to be aware of. These are the times when we will be administering statutory assessments to different age groups. The following are assessments that all children in these year groups complete throughout the country.

Year 6 Assessments (SATS): Monday 12th- Thursday 15th May

Year 4 Multiplication Check: Between 2nd June-14th June

Year 1 Phonics Screening: Between 9th June- 14th June

We will support all children throughout these assessments and encourage them to do their best- that is all we can ask and we are very proud of how hard the children are working. If you have any questions about any of these assessments, please get in touch with your child's class teacher.
