Years 5 and 6 will be working together to share their adults to best support the children. Both classes will have a main teacher, who will be the contact for that class and responsible for overseeing their learning. They will also both have their own classroom spaces. Due to the combined numbers in the two classes, these teams will work together on some parts of their curriculum, particularly in the afternoons or where they need bigger groups to really be able to get the most out of the learning. The children will work flexibly with all the adults across both teams, which will give them the opportunity to work with different people throughout the week. We are aiming to give the children more opportunities to develop friendships, to maximise the support available to them, and to improve their preparation for high school.

Mrs Williams and Mrs Cooke will work across the school, for example, teaching the children as part of teachers' non-contact planning time.

All children in all classes will take part in Transition Day on the 2nd July, where they will spend the day in their new teams. It is always a lovely day in school!

Sports Festival - 11th July

Our friends at St. Joseph's have very kindly invited us to use their school field for our Sports Festival again this year. This will take place on Friday 11th July in the morning.

In a similar way as in the past, children will work in mixed-age house teams to complete a range of activities, led by Team 6, to earn points for their houses. We would love it if you could join us for this. Please drop the children off as normal at school (and ensure children are on time) and then arrive at St. Joseph's at no earlier than 9:15 am. We aim to start at 9:30 am. Children will be bringing a letter home soon letting you know which house team they are in. They are welcome to wear a suitable t-shirt of this colour along with their PE shorts. Please ensure t-shirts have sleeves, and children wear sun cream and bring a sun hat. If children do not have a t-shirt of that colour, please do not feel you need to buy one- their school PE t-shirt is also an option.
