On Thursday 9th July, children will take part in our transition day. They will spend the day in their new classes and meet the adults that will be supporting and teaching them in September.



Mrs Williams (Deputy Headteacher) and Mrs Cooke (SENCO and Inclusion Lead) will continue to teach across the school, teaching classes during teachers' planning time.
