


A day in in Year 5 THIS IS A CHANGE TO LAST YEAR'S ROUNTINE

- 8.40am- Children enter school by the playground.

- · 3:20 End of school day






3.20pm End of the school day.




PE-Bags to be kept in lockers.

Goes home on Friday to be handed in by following Thursday. This will usually comprise of spellings and maths activities.






School reading scheme
