Routines

➤ Water Bottles

Currently we have our water bottles on our desk throughout the day, if the water bottle doesn't have a sports cap your child will be asked to keep it by the sink to avoid any large spills. ➤ Snacks

➤ PE

PE lessons are currently on Monday and Thursday. Please ensure your child has their PE kit on for school on these days and any earrings removed. Children can wear their school jumper and navy/black/grey jogging bottoms or leggings. They can wear black pumps or plain trainers.

Routines

➤ Lunchtime

Year 3 have playtime at 12.00 until 12.30 when they head in for lunch. Once children have finished eating, they can spend the rest of the time playing until end of lunch at 1pm.

No Nonsense Spellings

- Spelling will be taught in class as short discrete lessons. Spelling lists will not be sent home each week for a Monday test, instead we would like you to use a range of strategies to learn to spell the words from statutory word lists. To begin with we would like you to identify any tricky words for your child from the Year 3 and 4 word lists and help them to spell these independently. These can be found on our Class page on the school website.



Reading in Year 3

- Please continue to hear your child read regularly at least four times a week out loud and discuss with them what they read to check their understanding. Ideally, we would like the children to spend some time reading online using Oxford Reading Buddy (see separate PowerPoint on website).
- Children may also choose to read **one** ORT book and **one** free choice book.



Reading in Year 3

- Please remind your child to bring the book's they are currently reading to school each day as they may have an opportunity to read in the school week or asked to read to an adult.
- Children may want to read something different. We are encouraging reading for pleasure more than ever!
