

Curriculum Overview – Spring 2 2024

Year 2

English

In English we will be:

Editing and improving the writing of our own narrative story about a young bird.

Reading and writing our own persuasive leaflet for a place to visit.

Understanding more about grammar by rehearsing correct punctuation such as apostrophes for possession and contractions.

Maths

In Maths we will be:

Recalling number facts such as doubles, halves, bonds to 10, 20, 100 and times tables facts of 2, 5 and 10.

Learning how to measure and compare the length and height of objects using cm and m.

Learning to measure and compare mass, capacity and temperature.

Science

As Scientists we will:

Observe and compare the basic needs of animals, including humans.

Learn about the life cycles of different animals and the stages of life of animals and humans. We will observe how animals, including humans, change as they grow.

PSHE

'Rights and Responsibilities'

We will be discussing how we can get on better with others and what we can do if we find this difficult.

We will discuss how we can show responsibility for our environment. We will also think about how we can be more responsible for our money and how we use it.
