If you would like to, please choose one of the following to complete each week (you can do them in any order!)

1. **History** – Preston Football Heroes - Research one Preston football hero or Preston North End fact and create 5 interesting facts to share with the class. You could create a video, presentation, timeline or poster for the working wall!
2. **Computing** – Microbits - Design a simple idea for a gadget or invention that uses movement sensors and explain what it would do and who it would help.
3. **Science** – Light - Investigate shadows at home by using a torch or sunlight and record how shadows change size or direction during the day.
4. **DT** – Structures: Playgrounds - Sketch your dream playground and label the different structures, explaining which materials would make them strong and safe.
5. **PE** – Athletics and Rounders - Practise one athletics skill or rounders skill at home and be ready to explain how practice helped you improve.
6. **PSHE** – High School Transition - Talk with a family member about starting high school and write down three pieces of advice or questions you still have.
