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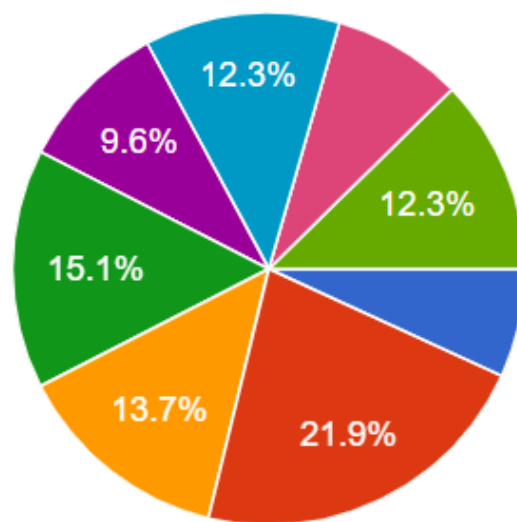
Summary of Findings

- 73 parents completed the survey in July 2025.
- 100% of parents who completed the survey agreed their child is happy at St. Catherine's.
- 97.3% of parents who completed the survey stated that their child feels safe at St. Catherine's.
- 97.3% of parents who completed the survey agree pupils at St. Catherine's are well- behaved.
- 100% of parents who completed the survey agree their child is well looked after at St. Catherine's.
- 98.6% of parents who complete the survey agree their child is taught well at St. Catherine's.
- 100% of parents who have a child with SEND, agree that St. Catherine's gives their child the support they need to achieve.

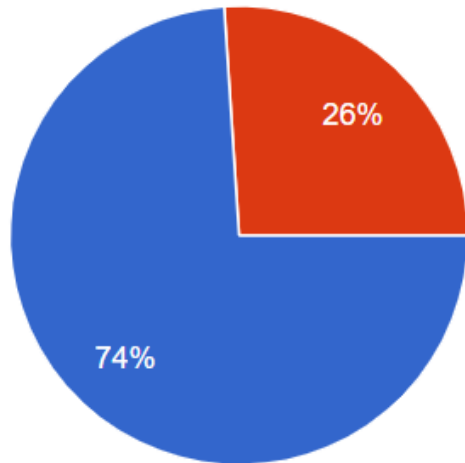

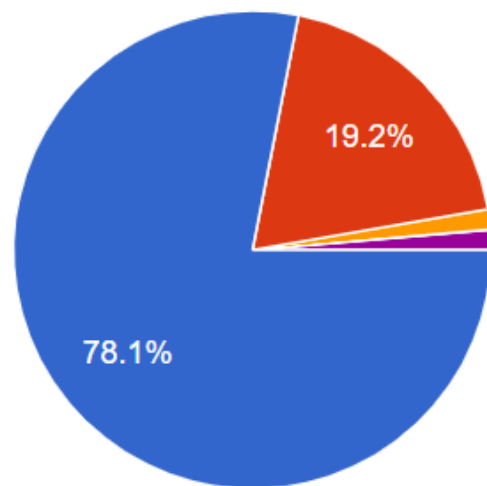

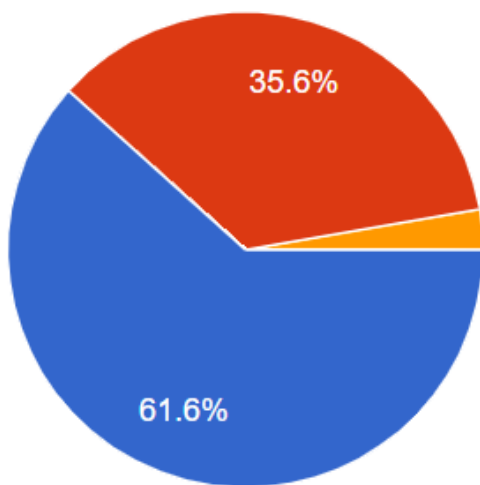

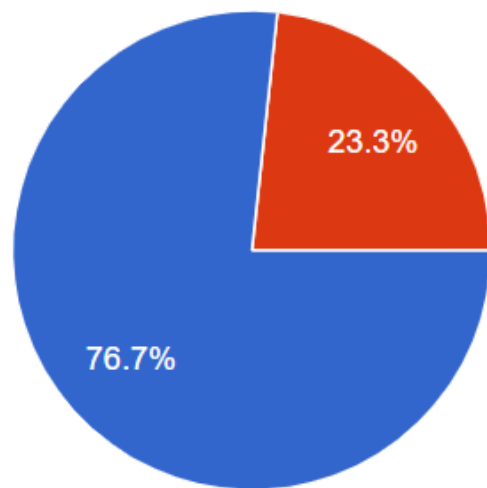

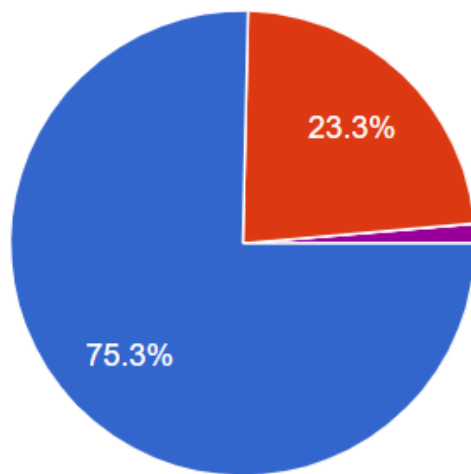

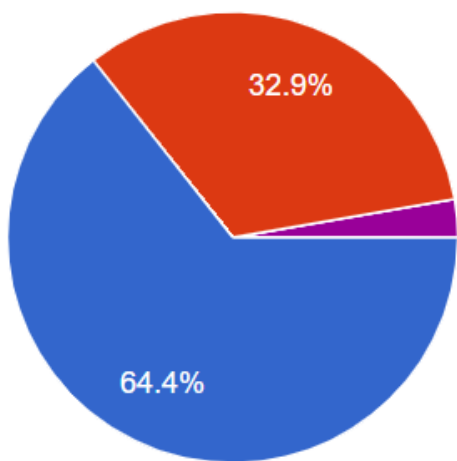

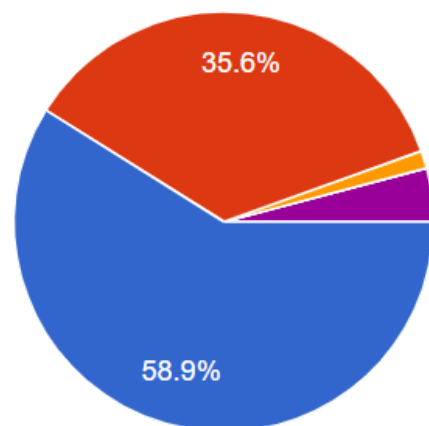

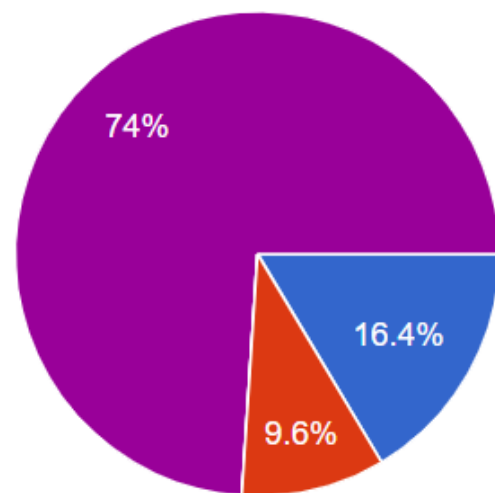

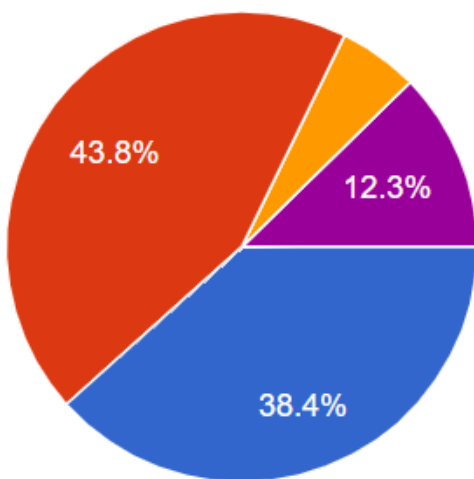

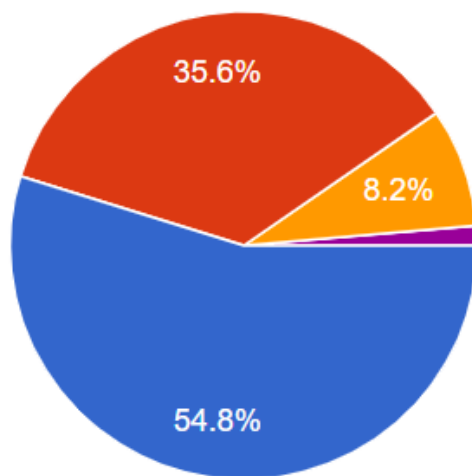

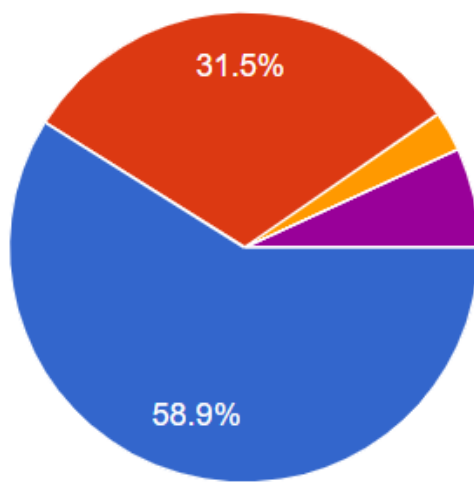

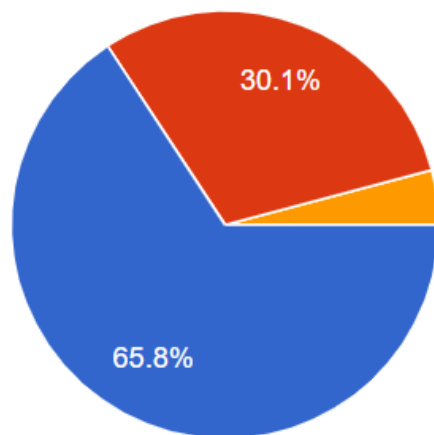

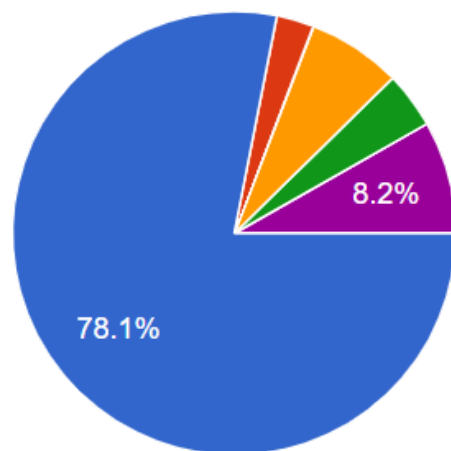

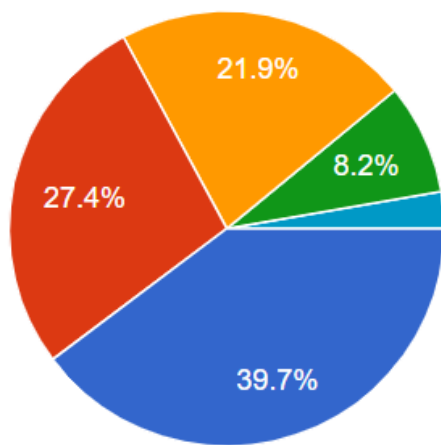

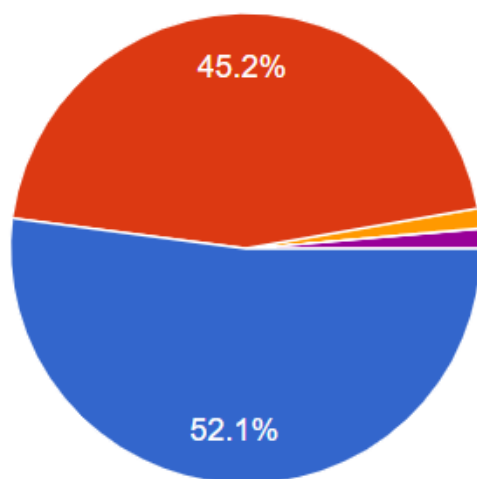

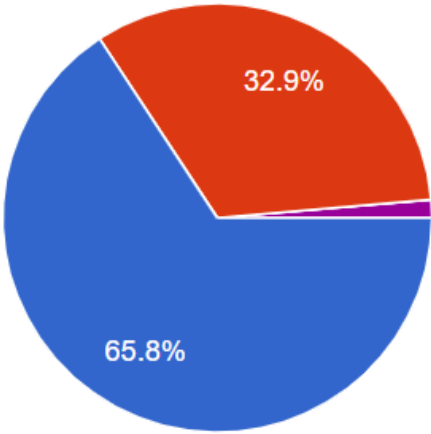

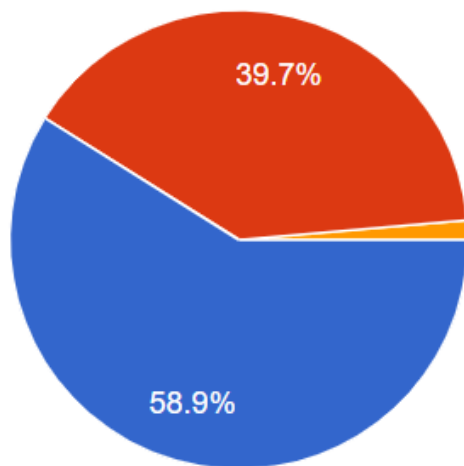

Children are happy.

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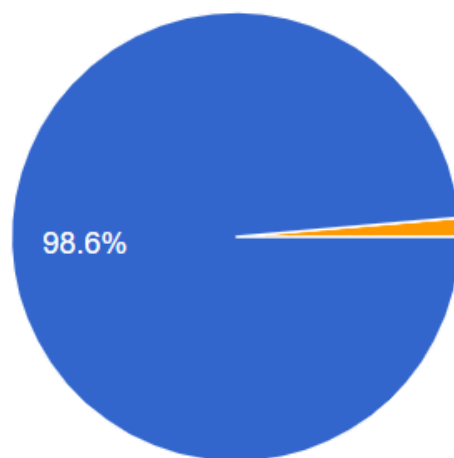

As a family we are really blown away by the care our son has received. We are incredibly grateful for the nurturing staff and the importance that is placed on producing kind students. We appreciate the opportunities children receive and like that it's not all desk based!

It's a wonderful school, with amazing staff and both my children have been/are very happy at St Catherine's.

The level of support my child has had from every member of staff is outstanding!

Provide pictures for the children in older years we have nothing once they leave reception/year 1 we are told plenty of pictures will be taken but we never see them, could we have an app like evidence me or use something in the spider app to communicate pictures of what the children are doing within the classrooms from the older year groups. We have no memories from the sports days or other fun activities they do these are the most precious years for our memories during school. They grow up fast and all we have are the school books at the end of the year.

I have noticed all year, not just a one off, the amount of rubbish and litter in the school playground. This isn't after an event, it is constant. I feel it sets a bad example to the children for their surrounding to be so untidy and messy.

I feel St. Catherine's has a dedicated staff team who always go above and beyond for the children.

I have noticed that St Catherine's has lower extracurricular provisions than other schools and I do think that there is room for improvement with physical education and wider development with more after school and pre school activities.

The parent craft sessions etc... can be tricky for working parents!
In a term it can be difficult for parents to get to a worship, sports day, craft event etc... it is lovely. But it is also difficult to attend and then you child feels let down by parent if they can't get to it.
The opportunity to see your child's books during the year on an early evening is also lovely and very rewarding for the child.
Nice way for the child to celebrate what they are doing.
