

Homework Expectations

As a school, we have recently made a few changes to our homework policy, which reflect the work we are doing with the children in school. Please see below the information regarding homework expectations in KS2.

Spellings: Spelling homework is not compulsorily, as we are now spending dedicated time each day following the Read Write Inc Spelling program. If children would like to practice spellings at home, they can log onto the practice zone on Oxford Owl or practice their year group words which can be found on the school website.

Reading: Children are expected to read 5 times each week. Books will be given to the children based on their current reading ability and reading records will be checked weekly to make sure children are reading at home.

Maths: Children are expected to log into TT Rockstars/Numbots for the following amount of time each week:

Years 3 and 4: 10 minutes

Year 5: 12 minutes Year 6: 15 minutes

Creative Homework: Children will be given creative homework each term, and while it is optional for them to complete it, it really is another way for them to showcase their knowledge of their current Enquiry topic.

Additional homework may be sent home with your child if they have any areas they need to focus on at home with an adult.

Year 6s will receive homework to complete during the run up to SATs related to any targets they have in Maths, Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar or Reading.
