Summer 1 Term Learning Letter 2026

In English, we are learning to stories with a new ending looking at 'Emma Jane's aeroplane'. We will develop our knowledge of adjectives and build great descriptive sentences. We will strengthen our knowledge of information texts by writing a holiday leaflet. We will use a wide range of appropriate vocabulary and our best punctuation. We will explore a range of pattern poems. We will continue to work on our handwriting and concentrate on the size and form of our letters. We will start to join out letters in the correct

In Maths, we will continue to build our knowledge of number by using Place Value to compare and estimate numbers.

We will continue to learn our 2,5 and 10 x tables and use inverse to learn related division facts.

We will calculate time and read and write time using 5-minute increments. We will begin to answer position, direction and movement questions, describing turns to solve problems.

In DT, we will create a Beach Bag. We will cut, shape and join fabric, use basic sewing techniques such as a running stitch and choose materials and explain why they are being used depending on their characteristics.

Our Learning Theme is ... 'Places People Go'

In RE, we will explore which books are sacred to Christians, Muslims and Jewish people. We will look at similarities and differences between the religions.

In Geography, we will study the places that people go on holiday. We will look at how to locate a capital city using at Atlas. We will look at a range of human features in famous cities. We will also look at different climates around the world and discuss why some places have different weathers.

In Science, we will be exploring different materials. We will name and classify materials and their properties. We will know objects are made out of certain materials because of their properties and know how materials can change form when a force is applied.

In RHE/ PSHE, we will explore money. We will learn that money comes from different sources and is used for different purposes. We will discuss moral questions about money and consider how to save money and conserve energy. We will think about how to raise money for charity and carry out a fundraising activity for their chosen charity.
